- 1. Rules:** The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, the Prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association, Class Rules and Haversham Sailing Club's Sailing Instructions.

Racing Rules 27.1 and 40 will be changed to the effect that buoyancy aids are required. The changes appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. Competitors should note that Haversham Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book and at the point of event entry.

- 2. Eligibility & Entry:** The regatta is open to all boats of the Byte class (C1, C2 and Classic Rig). Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on the day. This will be available on the morning of the event from 09h00.

- 3. Entry Fee:** An entry fee of £15 is payable on the day. This does not include food; a galley will be available

- 4. Schedule:** Six races are scheduled for the event, with five results to count. A competitors' briefing will be held in front of the club balcony at 10h30. Start times will be approximately as follows:-

**Saturday 1100, 1330, 1500**

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 10h55.

**Sunday 1000, 1130, 1330**

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 09h55.

- 5. Sailing Instructions:** The Sailing Instructions are available on the club website: [www.havershamsc.org](http://www.havershamsc.org) Additional copies will be made available at the time of entry.

- 6. Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> places.

- 7. Risk Statement:** Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, umpires and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

- 8. Insurance:** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of at least £2,000,000 or the equivalent.
